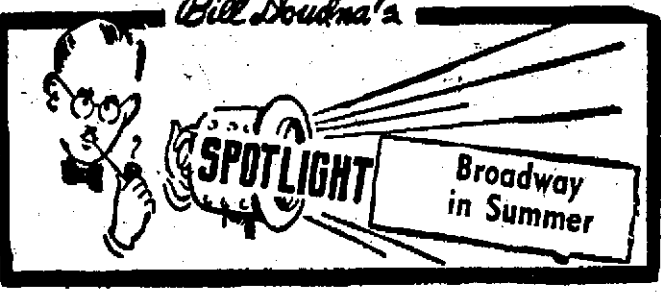

NEW YORK—The summer visitor to New York need have no night club worries. There are plenty of spots open, from the quiet East Side saloons to the big-show Broadway-type cabarets.

Lou Walters can always be counted upon to provide a full-length, colorful show at his Latin Quarter in the heart of the theater district. Right now he has a couple of headliners new to New York cafes who are doing a fine job.

They are Edith Fellows and Tommy Dix. Both come from the stage. You may remember Edith as a child player in scores of movies. They have put together a boy-and-girl singing act that has tremendous polish.

If two persons can be said to suggest successfully a tabloid musical comedy, they do it. Besides having voices of much better than the usual night club calibre, they are adept at clowning.

The Terrace room of the Hotel New Yorker is back on an ice-show basis after a lapse of several months resulting from the management's decision that the 20 percent cabaret tax was ruining business. With a cut in this federal bite in prospect, the entertainment has been resumed, including the return of "name" bands to the room.

The current band is that of Bernie Cummins, the 100th orchestra to play the room. And Cummins, incidentally, opened the room with his group back in 1930.

Samy Kaye is on the Starlight roof of the Waldorf Astoria, pleasing customers with his "want to lead a band" routine and his music in general. Also on the bill at this spot, which this year for the first time has added entertainment besides a band, is the singing group of four men and Paula Kelly known as the Modernaires. It is one of the best acts of its kind.

Tommy Dorsey and his band are featured at the Astor. The Roosevelt Grill is staying open for the summer this year and now has the recently formed band of Teddy Powell, the songwriter. The Cafe Rouge of the Hotel Statler also is

16 Freighters, 3 Tankers Derailed; No One Hurt
NEW HOLLSTEIN (UP)—Sixteen freight cars and three tankers of a north-bound Milwaukee Road train were derailed here early Monday, but no one was hurt.

The three tankers burst into flame and volunteer firemen fought the blaze for more than three hours. The derailed cars were part of an 89-car train bound for Green Bay.

The derailment happened about 300 yards from a stove gas storage yard, but police said the gas tanks were not endangered.

No estimate of damages has been made yet, and officials are investigating to determine the cause of the wreck.

Passenger service over the tracks was re-routed by bus to Green Bay.

Florence Man Found Dead on Fishing Trip
FLORENCE, Wis. (UP)—A searching party of about 100 men found Ford Roberts, 34, Florence, dead near Leroy Creek 25 miles west of here Monday after he had disappeared on a fishing trip.

He evidently died of a heart attack, authorities said. He still clutched a fishing pole when the searching party found him in a wooded area near the creek.

Roberts had gone fishing Sunday with his brother-in-law, Jack Roehon. When he failed to return to the car late in the day, Roehon called for help to look for him.

Fifty men searched all night and 100 men relieved them Monday morning.
