L. A. International Airport Expanding

LOS ANGELES, July 27. (AP) Facilities of the Los Angeles International Airport are being increased immediately because of fast-moving events abroad, the department of airports manager said today.
Adm. J. W. Reeves Jr. said the two east-west runways, on which 80 per cent of the operations takes place, will be lengthened from their present 6400 feet to 7500 and 10,000 feet.
A building will be constructed to house consolidated airport services, another to handle air freight and two more hangars will be built.
The projects are part of the huge airport's long-range expansion program.
