Chamber Music

TIP-O'-THE-MORNING: "Roundy" Coughlin's broadcast on WIBA at 7:30 p. m. Friday will come from Chicago, where he will see the All-Star football game.

Superior performances marked an evening of chamber music which the University of Wisconsin music school presented Wednesday night in Music Hall. The comparatively short program delighted the audience, which appeared to want only more music.

Harry Peters, who last week won plaudits for a performance in the same hall, did it again. He appeared with a small string group in the last two movements of Cimarosa's "Concerto for Oboe and Strings," a flowing Siciliano and a swinging allegro giusto.

Peters' tone was a peculiarly effective one, round and smooth yet with a sufficiently ready quality for contrast with the violins, viola, cello, and bass.

Another instrument rarely heard here either in solo or in ensemble is the French horn, and Wendell Hoss demonstrated its versatility in Brahms' "Horn Trio in E-Flat Major," in which he was joined by Emil Heermann, violin, and Leo Steffens, piano.

Here was a case in which the musicianship of the performers outshone the music itself, for the group—and Hoss in particular—played with notable composure yet with a distinct consciousness of their instruments' differences. The main theme could well be stolen by the popular songwriters, was a joy to hear.

Dvorak's unusual "Dumky Trio," a collection of contrasting
