

"When the smoke had cleared, North complained bitterly about South's 'closing' bid of three notrump. He maintained that by jumping to a game bid South had shown no interest in slam. If that were really South's message when he bid three no-trump, North could hardly afford to bid a slam single-handed.

"South claimed that there is no such thing as a 'closing' jump to game in no-trump. He said that a jump to three no-trump shows considerably more than a jump



to two no trump. If South has a hand that was too strong to jump to two no trump. North should not worry about his partner's in-tentions. The hand must be worth a slam whether South wanted one or not.

South is 100 per cent right. The response of three no-trump shows just about the same strength that is needed for an opening bid one no-trump. It indicates a hand with all of the unbid suits stopped and probably some help in the bid suit. The total strength is about three and a half honor tricks.

Obviously a hand that shows three and a half honor tricks opposite an opening bid cannot be anxious to stop at game. If the original bidder has extra strength there ought to be a play for slam and the responder is just as anx-


