Losing Trick Is Often Way to Assure Making Contract

Generous George looked carefully at the dummy and then beamed at his opponents. "I've already given you one trick for nothing," he said genially, "and I've just been racking my brain for a way to give you another trick. I think I can see a way to do it and you can be sure that there's no one I'd rather give a trick to than to my favorite opponents."

South hand, put up the jack of spades from the dummy. East covered with the king of spades, winning the trick. East promptly shifted to the king of clubs and Generous George smiled benevolently as he played a low club from his own hand and from the dummy. This was George's first gift to his opponents, but it didn't do them any good.

Dummy won with the king of diamonds and declarer took two rounds of trumps with the king and ace. George's next step was to lead the queen of spades from the dummy. East covered with the ace (it would have done him no good to play low) and George ruffed. George then led a trump to dummy's jack and led the seven of spades from the dummy. When East played low, George discarded a club from his hand. West won with the nine of spades and promptly returned a club through dummy's ace-jack. However, it was too late. Dummy won with the ace of clubs and George speedily cashed the six of spades.

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West had opened the 10 of spades. This seemed like a good lead at the time, in view of
