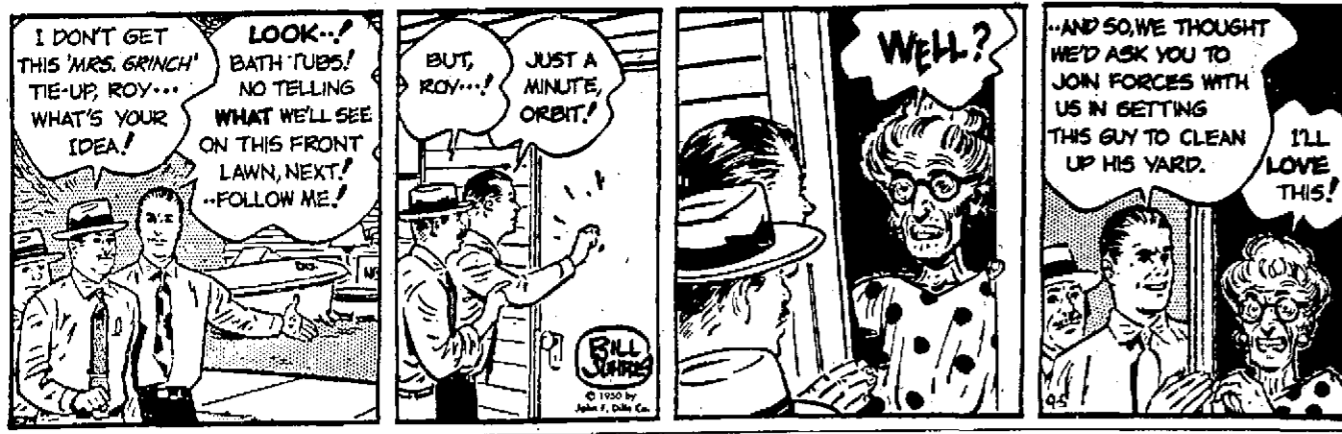

Blackwood on Bridge

Mr. Masters had five honor tricks, but by no stretch of the imagination could his hand qualify for an opening two bid. In order to make game he had to find his partner with considerable strength either in high cards or distribution. South dealer. Both sides vulnerable. North (Mr. Dale) S- J 5 4 2 H- Q J 7 5 D- K J 7 5 C- 8 5 4 West (Mr. Abel) S- K 7 H- K 9 8 6 5 D- 9 3 C- J 9 7 2 East (Mr. Champion) S- Q 8 6 3 H- 7 3 2 D- Q 10 6 C- Q 10 6 South (Mr. Masters) S- A 10 9 H- A 10 4 D- A 6 4 2 C- A K 3 The bidding: South West North East 1 C Pass 1 D Pass 2 N T Pass 3 N T All Pass He opened with one club to make it possible for Mr. Dale to respond. After Mr. Dale bid one diamond, Mr. Masters decided that, as far as his hand was concerned, no trump seemed to be the best spot. Having determined what to bid, the next question was "how many." This first rebid by the opening bidder is extremely important. It tells partner whether the opening bid was made on a minimum hand, a hand of medium strength or a hand that was just short of an opening two bid. Remember that if your first rebid is at no trump, you should bid the full value of your hand at once. Mr. Masters knows that, of course, and at first glance it appears that he has plenty to go all the way to game at no trump. He discounted his cards slightly, however, in view of his lack of a long suit and the scarcity of intermediate cards. His two no trump bid asked Mr. Dale to go three if he had a little more than he needed for his one diamond bid. With five picture cards in three suits, Mr. Dale decided he had enough to do the job, especially with Mr. Masters as declarer. Mr. Abel opened the six of hearts and dummy's jack held the trick. Now Mr. Masters paused a moment and noted that if he could successfully finesse the diamonds and take four tricks in that suit, he would have his game in the bag. But he didn't relish the idea of having the finesse lose and a heart returned through his ace-10. So he wisely decided to work on spades. A small spade was led from the board and the nine finessed. Mr. Abel won with the king and from his side of the table hearts could not be continued without losing a trick. He therefore shifted to the deuce of clubs. Mr. Masters won with the king, entered dummy with the king of diamonds and took a second spade finesse, which won. Now he didn't care who got in, as long as he could win two more diamond tricks. He laid down the ace and another diamond. Mr. Champion won the last diamond and returned a heart. But it was too late. Mr. Masters won two spades, two hearts, three diamonds, and two clubs for his nine tricks. REPORTS TO BASE Arthur H. Severson, son of Mrs. Jessie Severson, 2716 E. Parkway: FEATURE: Where the Sidewalk Ends. TYPE: Detective mystery in reverse. CAST: Mark Dixon, Dana Andrews, Morgan Taylor, Gene Tierney, Scallisi, Gary Merrill. REVIEWER: Helen Matheson. STORY: Detective Mark Dixon has an ugly reputation on the force for brutality. So when—in self defense—he accidentally kills a suspect, he knows no one will believe the truth. He uses his expert knowledge to cover up the crime but something goes wrong. And soon he discovers he has unintentionally framed the father of the girl he loves. HIGH POINTS: Dixon coolly goes about disposing of the dead man's body in full view of his half-dozing landlady... desperately trying to untangle the knot he's tied himself into, he attempts to beat a gangster into "confessing" the murder... and finally steels himself to try another solution... Andrews' tight-lipped, parsimonious, and often over-the-top, voiced portrayal of the detective... Gene Tierney who has nothing much to do but look lovely but does that with accomplished skill... Ben Hecht's smooth writing of the screen play, backed up with imaginative direction. LOW POINTS: In spite of obvious efforts, the attempt to duplicate the Andrews-Tierney chiller "Laura" doesn't quite come off—the inevitable outcome of the story being pre-determined by the movie's morality code. VERDICT: Much better than an average of its type. "Where the Sidewalk Ends" is persuasive and often exciting and good entertainment in its own right. It's only when you compare it to the memorable "Laura" that you get that let-down feeling.
