Building Boom Continues Here

MHA 'Credits' War for Spurt in July

The Korean war situation was cited by the Madison Housing Authority (MHA) Tuesday as the probable cause of a continued building boom in the Madison metropolitan area during July.

Area units under construction "zoomed to a new high of 1,208, the monthly report said, with permits, on the decline since the April peak of 225, swinging back upward from 171 in June to 211 in July.

Sees August 'Slump'
"Undoubtedly," the report added, "this drastic contra-seasonal increase is due to a rush to obtain material because of the Korean situation and fear of wartime rationing controls on building materials."

It expressed doubt that August totals, still to be compiled, would continue at the same feverish pace.

Total residential construction planned for the year hit a near all-time high of 966, more than double last year's 406, and rental type housing permits jumped from a disappointingly low level of six units in June to an encouraging
