GENERAL recruitment of volunteer social workers is vital to meet the war-created demands made upon the Home Service Department, he explained. The field director at the naval base also needs volunteers to assist in the welfare work there, which has been augmented by the war.

Nurse's aides are being recruited for the first time since World War II, to serve immediately at V. A. Hospital and blood banks, and train for emergencies. Staff aids, both men and women, are needed who can spare hours for clerical, secretarial and kindred service. Motor Service needs men for night driving, and women for day-time service.

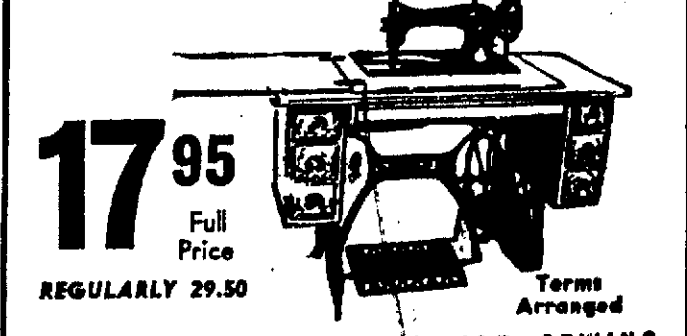
## Faulkner Enters Plea of Innocent

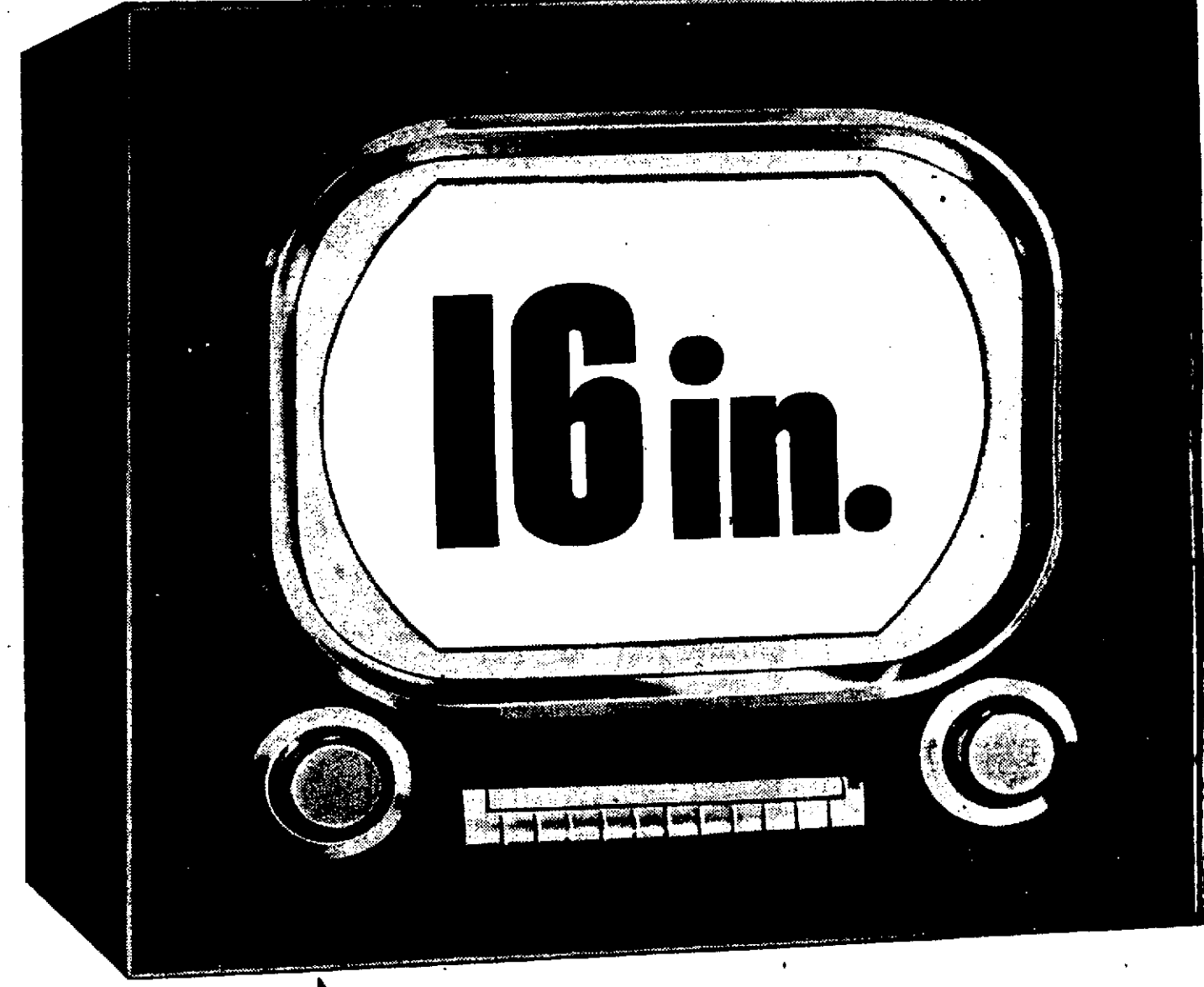
