This was Howard Duff jesting about Sam Spade, the radio sleuth Duff has been playing on the air. He admitted feeling a little lonely without Sam, from whom he parted company three weeks ago.

Warner Brothers has sued to stop the air show. Sam Spade is the character Humphrey Bogart played in "The Maltese Falcon" and the studio claims it owns all rights. The case has not yet been settled.
