**Bill Doudna's SPOTLIGHT Art and Artists**

**TIP O' THE MORNING:** Tom Ewell, former University of Wisconsin student, will play Willie in the film "Up Front With Mauldin," based on the famed World War II cartoons.

Thirty-four paintings in oil and casein by Aaron Bohrod, artist-in-residence at the University of Wisconsin, are on display in the Worcester Art gallery at Lawrence college, Appleton. The show will be open through Nov. 13. From Appleton, the exhibition will move to the Winneconne community schools for showing through December. The paintings will be on view at the new Rahr Civic center in Manitowish water at the Winneconne showing. That exhibition will coincide with inaugural ceremonies for the center. "Farm Ruins," an oil by Bohrod, was among the paintings invited for display at the current diamond jubilee exhibition of the Art Students league in New York. Bohrod is a former league student. The painting was inspired by a view of a group of abandoned buildings near Baraboo. It was in Bohrod's one-man show at the Memorial Union last year. Gabor Peterdi, whose work is included in the current show at the Wisconsin Union theater gallery, now has a one-man show at the Laurel gallery, New York. Subject of the eastern show is the New York scene, and about 25 prints and large oils are included.
