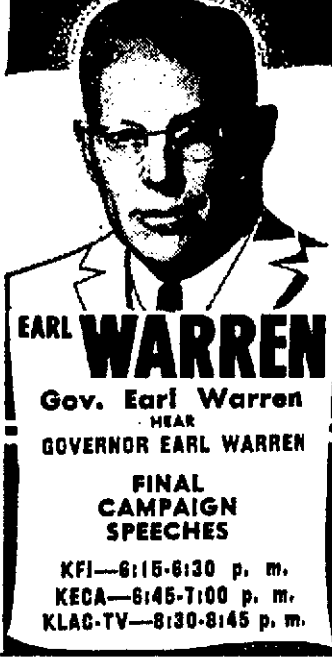
14 More Killed
