Meredith Willson Upholds Margaret Truman's Voice

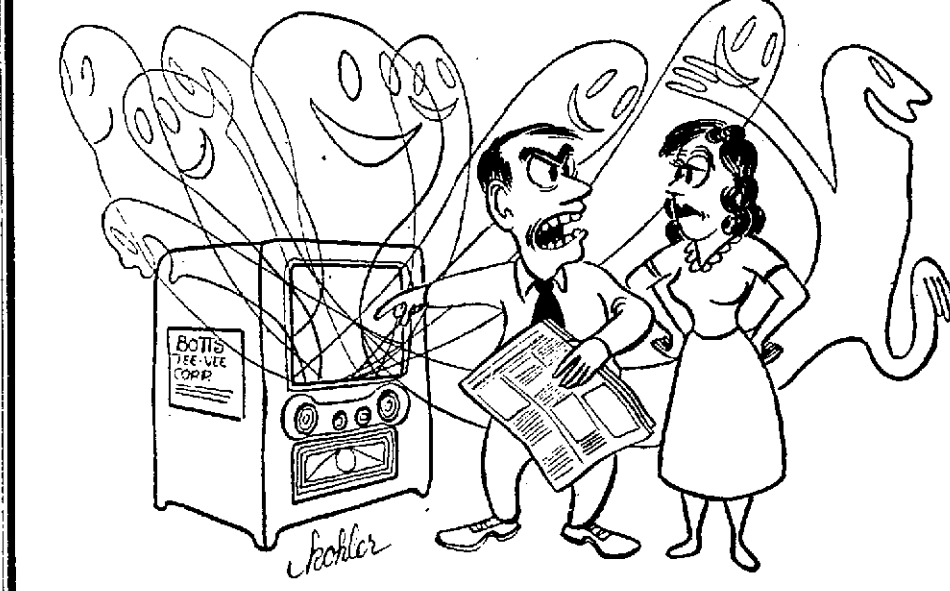

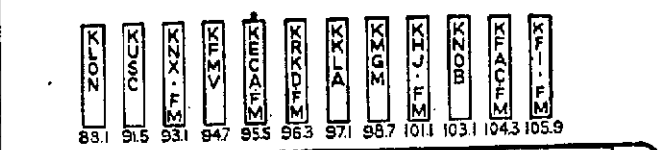
