Briton Jailed on Polish Charge

WARSAW, Poland, Dec. 18. (AP) Capt. Claude H. Turner, 44, former British air attaché here, was sentenced today to 18 months in jail on a charge of persuading a pretty Polish girl to attempt to leave this country illegally.
Two others, named as Turner's accomplices in the case, were sentenced to seven months in jail. They are Henry Upperton and Gordon Nelmes, both of the motorship Baltavia. They were to be released at once, however, because seven months has elapsed since their arrest, during which they have been imprisoned.

2 Swans Save Life of Would-be Suicide

GENEVA, Switzerland, Dec. 18. (AP) Two swans saved the life of a would-be suicide in the Rhone River here last night, Geneva police reported today.
Marcel Schafroth, 25, threw himself in the river in the center of the city, the police report, after someone had stolen his entire savings of 60 francs (\$14). The cries of two swans attracted attention to Schafroth as he was about to be swept over a weir in the darkness.
