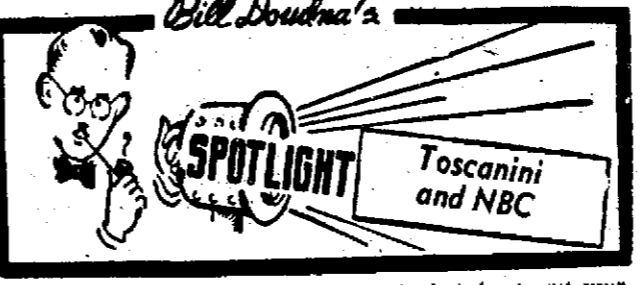

TIP O' THE MORNING: Today is the last day to get your ballots to us in The State Journal radio poll. Three programs are far in front in their classes at the moment—"Halls of Ivy," Metropolitan Opera, and "America's Town Meeting."

Arturo Toscanini's absence from broadcasts by the NBC Symphony orchestra has started all sorts of rumors—that he would switch to another network, that he was angry over NBS's shifting his program from his favorite studio, that he wanted an audience, that he didn't want an audience, and so on.

Among the facts in the matter are these, as recorded by W. G. Rogers, arts editor of the Associated Press: A month ago Toscanini told friends that he would not again conduct the orchestra. His son, Walter, denied the rumors of a switch, but told NBC his father was suffering a leg injury, and has been under a doctor's care intermittently since that time. He is scheduled to conduct in Britain in the spring.

NBC expects him to be back Jan. 27. And here is what Rogers has to say about the situation: "The deciding day, it now seems, will be either Jan. 27, Saturday, or Jan. 29, Monday. The Toscanini contract calls for 12 broadcasts and the dates for six have passed.
