Nuevo Laredo Building Set

SPECIAL CORRESPONDENCE NUESTRO LAREDO.—Mayor Juan de Dios Hinojosa has announced plans for construction of a municipal building slated to cost around 1,500,000 pesos.

The new building is to be erected at the intersection of Avenida Guerrero, Nuevo Laredo's main business street, and the present Mexican National Railways tracks. The tracks are to be removed during the railway's present expansion program.

Hinojosa said the federal government owes the municipal government 200,000 pesos in gold, around 1,500,000 pesos at the current exchange rate, and that the money will be used to finance the municipal building.

All municipal offices at present are located in the federal building in the downtown area.
