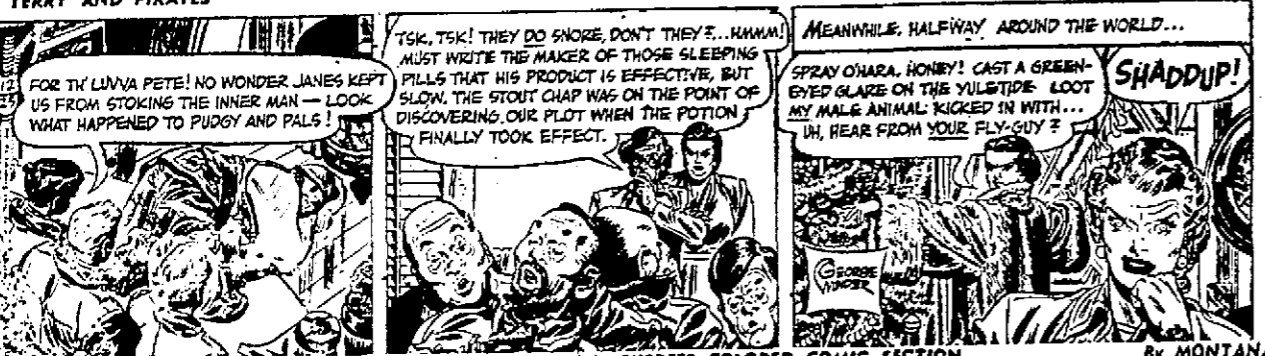


# Merry Christmas
