Soldiers Observe Early Island Yule

KWAJALEIN, Monday (AP)—Chaplain Maj. Stephen T. Mayer ushered in one of 1950's earliest Christmases today with a midnight mass for 200 military personnel and dependents on this mid-Pacific atoll west of the international date line.
It was still early Sunday morning, Dec. 24, in the United States when the services were held on this tropic isle.
For the chaplain it was the first of two Christmases. Later in the day he was to fly across the international date line to Johnston island, 1,800 miles eastward, arriving the afternoon of Dec. 24 to celebrate another midnight Christmas mass for that island's 80 servicemen.
Maj. Mayer is the U. S. military air transport service's commuting chaplain for Kwajalein, Johnston and Majuro.
