Kohler to Speak at Inaugural

Program Set for New Year's Day

Walter Kohler will give his first speech as governor of Wisconsin immediately after he is sworn in on New Year's day.
The complete program for the inauguration of Kohler and the other four state constitutional officers was announced Wednesday.
Kohler is the only one scheduled to speak.
All officers will be sworn in by Chief Justice Oscar Fritz of the state supreme court.
Kohler and Vernon Thomson, who will become attorney general, are the only new state officials. Lieut. Gov. George Smith and Treasurer Warren Smith will step into their second terms and Secretary of State Fred R. Zimmerman will step into his ninth. All are Republicans.
The inauguration will start at noon in the rotunda of the capitol. It will be preceded by a 15-minute concert by the Wisconsin National guard 32nd division band. Leroy Luberg, assistant vice-president of the University of Wisconsin, will be master of ceremonies, aided by Adj. Gen. Ralph Olson.
Military police of the 32nd di-

vision and Boy Scouts from Madison and Kohler's home town, Kohler, will escort him.

The program includes songs by the University of Wisconsin men's chorus, Catholic Bishop William P. O'Connor, Madison, will give the invocation and Methodist Bishop H. Clifford Northcott, the benediction.

All state officers will hold informal public receptions in their offices from 1 to 2:30 p. m.
