**Christmas Buying Up Sharply Here**  
 Christmas buying in San Antonio boosted retail store sales 10 per cent over the corresponding period of a year ago, the Federal Reserve Bank has reported. The Associated Press reported the bank's figures which also showed Houston gaining a brisk 24 per cent increase; Dallas making a 21 per cent gain, and Fort Worth registering a 14 per cent increase in department store sales.
