SPOTLIGHT

Ralph Kirkpatrick

TIP OF THE MORNING: Watch for a rash of pictures about the ballet. Howard Hughes signed "Les Ballet de Paris" soon after Samuel Goldwyn engaged Moira Shearer... Strange this didn't happen sooner, in view of the success of "The Red Shoes."

A musical event of major importance attracted an audience of more than 800 to Music Hall Sunday night, an audience so large that it required extra chairs in the auditorium and on the stage.

The recital was by Ralph Kirkpatrick, one of the world's few masters of the harpsichord; the music was Bach, most of it rarely heard here. The program was the last in a series sponsored by the University of Wisconsin music school in commemoration of the 200th anniversary of the composer's death.

Major work was the "Goldberg Variations," a monument in musical history. Bach himself, said the program notes, considered the volume of which it was a part "possibly... his most important work for keyboard instrument" up to 1742.

As a whole, these variations are difficult to assimilate at one sitting, but individually they are most enjoyable. Even the novice could never call them dull. They have touches of sadness, expressions of gaiety, and even some fun-making; one in particular reminds you of a kitten chasing its tail. The 30 variations are framed by a grave sarabande.

The program opened with the sparkling, swiftly-paced "Fantasy and Fugue in A Minor" and continued with "Capriccio in B Flat on the Departure of a Beloved Brother," which comes as close to being colorful, story-telling music as the chaste harpsichord, which doesn't lend itself much to sensuality, will permit.

A finished artist, Kirkpatrick is self-offacing at the keyboard. He lets his audience know at once that he is there to play Bach, not recordings.

Fete Planned to Honor Composer's Birthday
MILWAUKEE — (AP) — A nationwide celebration of the 75th birthday, Feb. 28 of John Alden Carpenter, American composer, will be sponsored by the national arts foundation, its director, Carleton Smith, New York announced. Symphony orchestras and singers, including Marion Anderson and Kirsten Flagstad, will perform Carpenter's works in concerts and broadcasts, Smith said. Smith is on a Midwest lecture tour. He said Carpenter, a resident of Chicago, is the dean of American composers and is now at work on a symphonic work for cello, commissioned by Gregor Piatigorsky, world renowned cellist.
