NEW YORK, Jan. 20. Large scale withdrawals of American missionaries from Communist China should not be construed as the end of Christian work in that country, the National Council of the Churches of Christ in the U. S. A. said today.

The announcement was made in a prepared statement by Dr. Rowland Cross, Far Eastern Secretary of the council's division of foreign missions.
