The wit, the keen mind, the human spirit, the deep love of justice Oliver Wendell Holmes are reflected clearly in "The Magnificent Yankee." This is a love story, and a real one. Calhern's performance is as magnificent as the man he portrays, as honest in conception as Holmes was in spirit. Edward Franz plays Louis Brandeis convincingly, and Miss Harding is excellent as Mrs. Holmes. Ian Wolfe is first-rate, too, as Adams, the chronic worrier, but Philip Ober makes something of a stuffed shirt out of author Owen Wister. There is some good work, among the Holmes secretaries, who replace for a time the sons he was denied.
