Looter of Garage Surprised, Dashes as Bullets Fly

A fast, slender burglar suspected of looting a garage early this morning as he hopped fences, dodged bullets and finally escaped in a car.

Police Officers Melvin L. Jordan and Robert L. Hemrod wheeled their squad car into an alley in the 3700 block of Walnut Ave. after they heard a loud, suspicious noise at 4:15 a. m.

As they stepped out to investigate they saw the suspect climb over a fence and run in the opposite direction. Shouting for him to halt, they fired two warning shots in the air.

Four more times the officers fired shots but, although the suspect fell once, he quickly picked himself up and lengthened his lead.

At Rose Ave. and Bixby Rd., two blocks east and one block north of where the chase started, the suspect jumped into a car and sped away.

The officers discovered that a garage behind the home of Willard Lesy, 3720 Walnut Ave., had been ransacked, but nothing was reported missing.

Admission of Vets to Law Practice Without Test Hit

Admission of veterans to the practice of law without an examination would tend to lower the bar standards, Homer D. Crotty, president of the State Bar Association of California, warned Long Beach Bar Association at a meeting last night.

Crotty said that the state bar favors increase in salaries of some judges in the higher brackets, particularly for judges and justices in courts of equity.

Through legal aid service of the association there is no need in California for anyone to be without such help, if necessary, Crotty asserted.

The state bar president declared that in Communist countries, the first move of the government is to socialize the legal profession. In this way, people cannot select their own counsel but must accept the one appointed by the government.

Nathan O. Freedman, criminal lawyer now specializing in legal problems of the motion picture industry, spoke of the importance of a sense of humor.

Humor, Freedman said, is the balance between success and failure. Joseph A. Ball presided. Governors of the State Bar Association were guests of the association at the dinner.

O'Neill, Third Wife Have Rift

SALEM, Mass., March 31. (AP) Playwright Eugene O'Neill and his third wife, Carlotta Monterey O'Neill, have separated, Probate Court records disclose, and have started legal proceedings against each other.

The ailing 62-year-old dramatist petitioned Essex Probate Court to appoint a guardian for his wife, claiming she is insane. A Boston psychiatrist, Dr. Merrill Moore, joined him in the action.

Yesterday, Mrs. O'Neill asked separate support. She said she left their Marblehead home, Feb. 1, and now is living in Boston. She charged O'Neill was cruel and abusive.

The couple, married in 1923, have a daughter, Mrs. Cynthia Stamm of Sausalito, Calif. Two previous marriages of the Nobel and Pulitzer prize-winning playwright ended in divorce.
