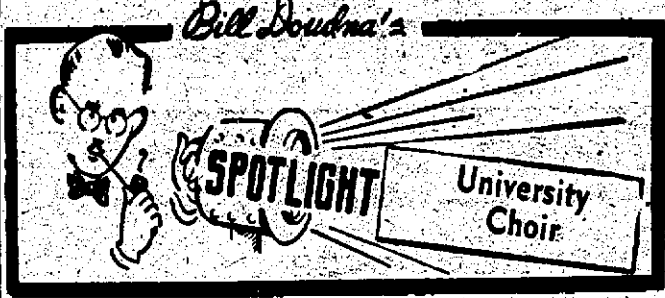

Reaching a climax in Ralph E. Williams' nature picture, "Views in the Night," the University of Wisconsin A Cappella choir gave its spring concert Wednesday night in Music Hall. Prof. Paul G. Jones conducted the chorus.

Williams' song was not only lovely to listen to but it made expert use of the inherently contrasting qualities of men's and women's voices, with deep basses accenting both the harmony and the text in the opening and closing sections.

The chorus was made up of voices of unusually good quality, perhaps the best such organization Jones has produced. It handled the dynamics of its numbers well, expanding and contracting the volume skillfully. Generally, it met the conductor's demands for precision, although there were some slips in a couple of numbers. It handled the unusual harmonies of Schoenberg and Hindemith with care, and made them sound appropriate for the songs at hand.

What the chorus lacked was clear enunciation, a vital point in such story-songs as Schoenberg's
