



FBI SEIZES GEMS WORTH \$32,800

NEW ORLEANS, April 6.—(AP) An expectant mother's tip led FBI agents to a \$32,800 cache of missing jewelry stashed away in a bank deposit box here.

Carrying out a court order, agents opened a deposit box yesterday and found a platinum diamond bracelet valued at \$24,000, a diamond wristwatch, earrings and clip

They matched a description of pieces missing from about \$90,000 worth of jewelry bought from New York dealers last October by say Lishansky paid for them with a check that bounced. About \$63,000 worth of the gems




