Long Beach Will Be Host to Children's TV Show

NEXT SATURDAY Long Beach will be the scene of plenty of youngster activity, when the KBNB television show "Komedy Klub" gives a free show for the kiddies at the Fox West Coast Theater.

High lighting the program will be a 70-piece band in a parade formation, with "hizzoner," the mayor, leading the procession. This information has come directly from Phil Berle, (brother of Milton Berle) who is the director of the "Komedy Klub."

The history of this show is very interesting. It all started about eight weeks ago when the program director of KBNB needed something for fill in time. They decided to use old time comedies. The show fell flat! There was nothing too interesting to adults in these "flickers" and most of the youngsters were Autry and "Hoppy" fans. Along came Arch Presby, an ambitious young fellow who is with NBC as a staff announcer. He proposed giving out membership cards, and appear on the show "live" before each film showing. He titled himself as "Uncle Archie" and announced that a club would be formed for this show. Better than 1300 letters requesting cards came after the first week, and to date there are 16,000 kid members.

With the youngsters . . . it's something for free . . . even if it's just piece of cardboard with printing on it . . . but to them . . . it's their very own club!

In Hollywood, over 2400 attended the first free show of the "Komedy Klub" at the Hollywood Pantages Theater, and now, next Saturday, Long Beach hosts the second.
