N.H.R.R. RATE HIKE IN N.Y.S. APPROVED

UTICA, N. Y., April 20 (AP) A special federal court today approved an eight per cent boost which became effective Friday on common railroad fares on New York, New Haven and Hartford railroad travel in New York State.

The three-judge court denied an injunction sought by the State Public Service Commission against the increased fares, ordered last Dec. 12 by the Interstate Commerce Commission.

The court's action climaxed a feud between the PSC and the ICC started in 1947. The PSC sought the injunction against the federal agency on grounds it had jurisdiction over rail fares within the state.

Although the railroad serves the New York City metropolitan area and several New England states, the ICC order raised the fares for persons traveling between two points within the state.

Members of the special court convened to hear the PSC application for an injunction were Charles E. Clark of the U. S. Court of Appeals, second circuit; J. Joseph Smith of the federal district court in Connecticut; and Stephen W. Brennan of the federal district court of northern New York.

In a 15-page opinion, filed in federal court here along with its decision, the court ruled that there was sufficient evidence to support the increased rates.
