### Star Not Present When Radio Show Goes on Tape

AN UNUSUAL story lies back of the broadcast of Edward Arnold's "Mr. President" tomorrow night. Arnold will present the show without even seeing his cast or doing any rehearsal with them.

It happened this way. The cast had been called for rehearsal of this program when at the last minute it was discovered that Arnold could not be present for the gathering. He had a commitment that he was unable to fulfill without a performance, or do the show without the services of the star. Deciding upon the latter, he taped the show using Ted DeCorcia, the program's narrator, in Arnold's role. Later he erased DeCorcia's version of "Mr. President" off the tape, leaving the dead spots for Edward Arnold to fill in.

The tape was played back once for Arnold to rehearse against, then later replayed with Arnold picking up his cues from a tape. A master tape was sent to operation to record the combined performance of Arnold and the tape bearing the cast.

Ted Toll edited the blended version for time, and when it is heard tomorrow night you'll never notice the difference. It will be heard over KECA at 9 o'clock.

Last week ABC thought it would dispose of 300 pictures of the "I FLY" show "Space Patrol" by announcing at the end of one of the shows that anyone writing in requesting a picture would receive an autographed copy. The announcement was yanked after the second time as the 300 would hardly stretch into the 4000 requests received. As of this writing, the mail is still swamping the office of John Hanson, ABC promotion chief. More pictures are being made, but no more announcements!

# U. S., USSR Stop Talk on Lend-lease Debt

WASHINGTON, May 8 (AP) The United States and Russia yesterday broke off their lengthy talks aimed at settling Moscow's bill for World War II lend-lease goods. Negotiations have been in progress here for several months, but when the deadlock continued yesterday they agreed to stop regular sessions. Talks may be resumed later. Russia got about \$10,800,000,000 worth of U. S. lend-lease goods. She has offered to settle for \$240,000,000. The U. S. has asked at least \$800,000,000.
