## Truman Warns of Different War

### Next One Will Hit at Home, He Says

WASHINGTON — (UP)—President Truman solemnly warned Thursday that the United States itself would be a "battleground" in another world war and said he is doing everything he can to prevent it by trying to achieve world peace.

He cautioned Americans that the situation in this country would be entirely different from World Wars I and II.

"This time, he said, "destruction" would rain on American cities, "freedom and everything else would be destroyed" and "we would probably go back to the dark ages."

**Permits Direct Quotes**  
Mr. Truman, speaking informally and in part voluntarily, painted that awesome picture of the effects of another war at his weekly press conference. At the request of newsmen, he took the unusual step of authorizing direct quotation of part of his statement.

He offered a general defense of his aims and policies after denying that he is "cocky," as some recent reports have pictured him. He said the proper word is "confident" and that he never wanted, and does not want now, to appear to have a "cocky attitude toward anybody."

The president's remarks appeared to be a further exposition of the reasons behind his decision to recall Gen. Douglas MacArthur, although the general's name was not mentioned.

**Aims for Peace**  
Mr. Truman said his whole program is based on "world peace" and the hope of preventing "another, a third, world war which would, in effect, I believe, destroy freedom and everything else in the world."

"We would probably go back to the dark ages if we have another, third world war," he said.

"If a third world war should come, we will not be in the position that we have been in the other two. We will be a battleground. We can look forward to destruction here, just as the other countries had in the second world war."

**INSTITUTE:** Plans for the third annual elementary music institute at the University of Wisconsin Aug. 14 and 15 include the expert services of three nationally-known music educators, Prof. Samuel Burns, in charge of the institute, has announced.

Prof. Gladys Tipton of the music education department, University of California at Los Angeles, will conduct classes in rhythmic experience, part singing, and music appreciation. Miss Tipton is co-author of the teachers' directions section of the Victor records for elementary grades.

Evelene J. Bell of the music staff of the John Mills school, Elmwood Park, Ill., will demonstrate teaching procedures with the help of students from the university summer laboratory school.

Prof. Arthur Williams of Oberlin conservatory will conduct a workshop in the construction of instruments by and for grade school children, with emphasis on the musical lore the children learn while building.

The institute is expected to bring more than 300 music educators from 20 states to the campus.
