Chiang's Voice on Pact Blocked

British Take Stand on Japanese Treaty

WASHINGTON (UP)—The British government has informed the United States that it will not sign any Japanese peace treaty to which the Chinese Nationalist government of Chiang Kai-shek is a party.

This was disclosed Friday by authoritative sources who also revealed that Britain has abandoned her insistence upon treaty limitations upon Japanese shipping capabilities.

These sources said they expected the Chinese representation question to be the major issue to be discussed when John Foster Dulles, Pres. Truman's special representative on treaty matters, goes to London early in June.

The British view against allowing Chiang to sign the treaty has been communicated to Asst. Secretary of State Dean Rusk and Dulles by the British ambassador, Sir Oliver Frank.

He pointed out that the British have acceded to the American demand that the Chinese Reds not be consulted on the treaty.

In return, according to authoritative sources, the British believe that Nationalist China likewise should not have a part.

The British have asked the United States to hold off having any Chinese government, Nationalist or Red, sign the peace treaty until there is a "general settlement" in the Far East.
