**MISCELLANEOUS**

A leaky vase or even a flowerpot can be made waterproof by coating the inside with melted paraffin. Use this same treatment if you wish to paint the outside of flowerpots. It prevents the moisture inside causing the paint to peel.

Screen doors should be fitted with spring hinges to keep 'em closed.

Joints in desk and bureau drawers that keep coming loose can be fixed once and for all by giving triangular corner blocks inside the joints. The blocks should be made out of hardwood.

Ordinary steel nails can be made rust proof by dipping them in molten solder.

Stuck screws often respond if they are heated for an instant with a soldering iron.

When sawing a piece of wood, always saw on the waste side of the line. This eliminates ending up with a piece of wood the width of the saw blade too short.

A plumb line can be held steady in the wind by submerging the plumb bob in a container of water.
