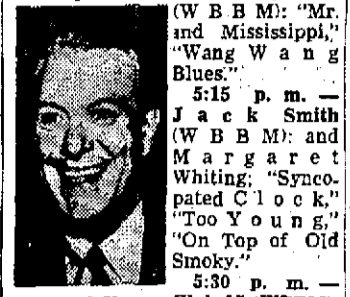

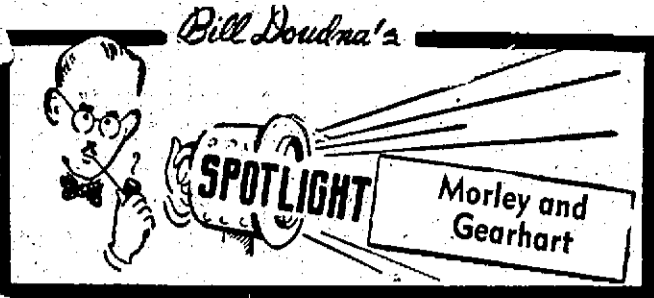

TIP O' THE MORNING: Two NBC serials move into new time spots July 2. "Just Plain Bill" will be at 4 p.m., "Front Page Farrell" at 4:15.

The kind of music an audience hums on the way home from the theater will be played by the young American, due-pianists, Morley and Gearhart, in the Wisconsin Union theater Friday at 8 p.m.

Fred Waring's two-piano team will open the program with "Four Waltzes" by Brahms, and follow with the famous "Variations on Theme by Haydn," also by Brahms. The second section of the program will include three numbers arranged by Livingston Gearhart for two pianos. They are "Cancan," Offenbach; "Pie en forme de Habanera," Ravel; "An American in Paris," Gershwin.

Chopin's "Rondo for Two Pianos, Opus 73," will follow, with "Prelude in G Minor," Rachmaninoff; "Stardust," Carmichael, and "Blue Danube Waltzes," by Strauss, Schulz, Evler, and Chasins, concluding the concert.

Livingston Gearhart and his wife, Virginia Morley, are noted for the ease with which they get acquainted with an audience during their concerts, and Gearhart always makes comments about the selections during the course of the program.

The musical couple will arrive by car next Friday, bringing their two matching Steinway pianos in a truck especially constructed for their use.

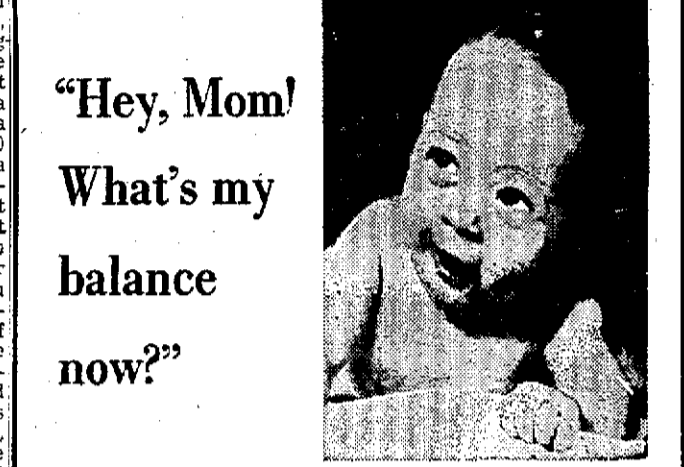
Van Heflin, currently in Universal's "Week-End with Father," has been poised over a long-term contract at that studio.

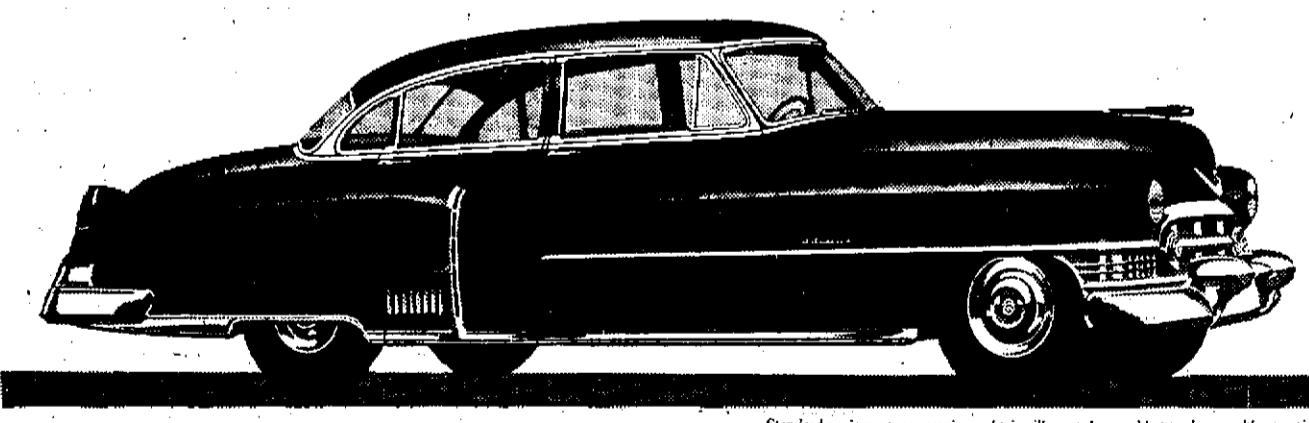
