The state department of agriculture advised thrifty housewives today that Wisconsin-grown fruits and vegetables are on the "best buy" list for July.

This is the month when the supply of fruits and vegetables from state farms and gardens is at its peak...

Among the fresh state-grown products which will be at their best in July are green peas, green onions, lettuce, snap beans, beets, and early cabbage...

While the largest Wisconsin strawberry production is past, berries from northern areas will be available in a week or two...

The department said that locally-grown fruits and vegetables are always of highest quality because of the shorter time between producer and consumer...

EAGLE RIVER — (U.P.) — Vilas County Judge Frank Carter announced Tuesday that he'd name an Eagle River administrator for the summer estate of Chicago's late Mayor Edward J. Kelly.

Carter turned down opposing petitions by Kelly's widow and Michael Mulcahy, Chicago, co-executors of Kelly's will...
