Doctor in the House

Operative X, one of this department's campus spies, comes up with some background information on last week's production of "The Heiress" at the Wisconsin Union theater:

Had anyone ventured to call "Is there a doctor in the house?" in the theater during the run of the Players' season opener, he would have been crushed in the resulting stampede. The boxoffice was flooded with ticket orders from the hospital staff at Wisconsin General, all of whom apparently weren't going to be caught outside the theater if their esteemed colleague, Dr. Bernard L. Lifson, could be caught on stage. As a result, probably a new record was established of doctors "in attendance."

That small "I" in Dr. Lifson's name, as printed in the play's program, is supposed to be that way. "The reviewers all changed it to a big 'I' when they attached the performance orchids to the doctor's name, but the fact is that Lifson gave himself that small middle initial during his undergraduate years as a stern reminder of the value of humility.

Those handsome crimson and white draperies and wall panels which were the dominant decorative note in the set for "The Heiress" were the original draperies and panels from Tripp Commons, a Memorial Union dining room. Director Fred Buerki keeps a sharp set designer's eye for any and all items in the Union scheduled for discard when there is redecoration in progress, since the original Italian renaissance decor yields up invaluable props for period settings. The impressive glass chandeliers he used in "The Swan" about two years back were originally in the Union's main art gallery.

The handsome pre-civil war costumes for "The Heiress" were rented from a Hollywood costumer. For instance, that white gown with the black trimmed sleeves which Marjorie Parkin wore, once graced the figure of Vivien Leigh in "Gone With the Wind"; the tight blue jacket with ruffy pink skirts, also worn by Miss Parkin, was previously Shirley Temple's; the maid's costume had been fashioned for Merle Oberon; the doctor's caped overcoat claims John Wayne as the original wearer; the doctor's green velvet dressing jacket was once Orson Welles', and the maid's apron had been fitted for Irene Rich's waist.
