Answer to Question No. 1
No, far less, judging from a survey of the Business and Professional Women's Club of California. A sample of over 5000 of the 15,000 members showed only 2 per cent divorced compared to about 6 or 7 per cent of women in general. More than half are married; 48 per cent have one or more children. Amazing to relate, they did not hesitate to state their age! What sensible women!

Answer to Question No. 2
Since this is a widely quoted remark of my own, I think it's 90 per cent true. For example, we have perhaps five excellent economists in Congress, but they have little influence on our economic policies. Every member of Congress and most citizens suddenly have become military strategists. Psychologists and psychiatrists have the knowledge to prevent or cure many mental problems, but don't have enough power to even kick quacks and ignoramuses out of practicing their bunkum. Artists know enough to make our cities beautiful—but also look at them!
