Networks Are Expanding Their Foreign Coverage

HOLLYWOOD. — The Atlantic Pact countries and developments there have loosened the purse strings of the various networks in regards to European coverage and their foreign correspondents. Most of all the networks are strengthening forces in the foreign countries for more expanded coverage of daily events.

ABC has recently announced that commentator Elmer Davis will fly to Europe on a fact-finding and reporting trip for a period of five weeks, during the latter part of July, during August, during which time he will visit the Atlantic Pact countries and report on the state of the defense of the western world. The Davis commentaries will originate from a European capital each Friday during his trip, with the first coming from Paris on Aug. 3. The following points will be Oslo, Stockholm, Frankfurt with the final from London on Aug. 31.

Meanwhile, Fulton Lewis Jr., travels to the international scene when he set sail yesterday for Western Europe on a two-month fact-finding trip. Lewis will be armed with a tape recorder, and he plans to document his week-day broadcasts by presenting on-the-spot interviews and eye-witness accounts of major develop-
