10% Wage Increase

OK'd by Phone Firm

OMAHA (UPI) — Northwestern Bell Telephone Co. and the CIO Communications Workers Union on Friday agreed on a new one-year contract granting 10 per cent wage increases to 18,000 employees in Iowa, Nebraska, Minnesota, North and South Dakota.

Northwestern said the figure included an 8 per cent boost granted voluntarily by the company last June.

It aid the union and company jointly would seek approval of the raise from the Wage Stabilization Board (WSB).

The telephone company already has filed for rate increases in Nebraska, Minnesota, and the Dakotas, and said it would be "necessary" to seek rate boosts in Iowa.
