

TASS MEN HELD FOREIGN AGENTS

NEW YORK Sept 7 (AP) Rep. Celler (D-N.Y.) said today a Justice Department spokesman has informed him that Tass news agency correspondents in this country are in the same class as foreign agents.

In fact, Celler said the department told him that three of the Soviet news agency's Washington writers have registered as agents of a foreign power.

"The Department of Justice now holds that members of Tass news agency are agents of a foreign power and not necessarily correspondents," the Brooklyn congressman said in a statement.

"This is a newspaper correspondent's job to cover their real activities."

POLICE CALL OFF HUNT FOR SUTTON

DANBURY, Sept 7—A search for an automobile believed to be operated by Willie Sutton, the notorious bank robber, ended almost as suddenly as it began here today.

Connecticut State police quickly blocked all highways leading into Danbury from the Connecticut-New York state line in a search for Sutton high on the FBI's list of wanted men.

Then, several hours later the search was called off without any explanation.

The Ridgefield barracks originally reported it was ordered to establish road blocks upon receipt of an alarm from New York state police this morning. The action came after a Yonkers, N. Y., patrolman noted a gray sedan traveling northward on a Westchester county parkway and identified the driver as Sutton.

Shortly after the Ridgefield barracks report, all state troopers were alerted.

In New York, police said a patrolman who collected a 10-cent toll from the driver thought the man's face was familiar. He consulted a number of police "wanted" circulars, found one bearing a likeness of Sutton and felt certain he was the driver.

PLASTIC WHALEBOAT INTRODUCED BY NAVY

PORTSMOUTH, N.H., Sept 7 (AP) The Navy today unveiled something new—a plastic whaleboat.

The "float" staff built at least three times stronger than its wood counterpart and was found to be the best ship at the Norfolk naval shipyard.

The hull made of thin layers of glass matting and glass cloth covered with resin is just a half as heavy as a quarter of an inch thick. A conventional whaleboat of the same size has a hull about an inch thick.

The new boat is lighter and drier since it won't rot and doesn't have to be painted.
