LOOKING AND LISTENING**Tallulah's London Arrival Draws Big Press Comment**

HOLLYWOOD. Not since the buzz bomb hovered over England has anything as explosive hit London as Tallulah Bankhead, who arrived there recently for the premiere of NBC's "The Big Show." The program, which has always held a high rating among the "intelligencia," seems to fall flat with "average" men and Mrs. Radio Listener" because of its incredible subtlety.

At great expense, the show has been returned to the airwaves for another season of "dahling this and dahling that," with the first show presented to the English will last Sunday. This same broadcast will be heard in the United States on Sept. 30 by recording over NBC network.

"Has Tallulah changed?" wrote Elizabeth Frank in the London News Chronicle. "She is nearly 20 years older, but then she has always been ageless. Now she is middle-aged, but there is nothing muddling about her." Miss Frank referred to Tallulah as "this strange goddess in mink and slacks."

A front-page London Daily Express story carrying arrival photographs of the fabulous and unpredictable actress was headlined: "As if Tallulah would sneak in . . ."

"The Senator's daughter from Alabama who became more Mayfair than any Londoner during her 10 turbulent years on the English stage did nothing so prosaic as to arrive," wrote Cecil Wilson of the Daily Mail. "She made an entrance."

Said Emory Pearce in the London Daily Herald which also ran a front-page story: "The tawny legend with the husky voice came to London last night on her first visit since 1935. And everyone within a big radius soon learned Tallulah was back in town."

At a press conference held at the Ritz Hotel, which insisted on the designation of "cocktail party" and not press conference, Tallulah started things rolling by drinking champagne out of her slipper. She danced the Charleston with a middle-aged man, talked volubly about radio, sugar Ray Robinson and Shakespeare.
