Jerry Gray's Orchestra on Many Major Programs

HOLLYWOOD. Contrary to general thinking, the Monday through Friday program heard over KNX known as Bob Crosby's "Club 15," does not feature the music of the Crosby band. In fact, the band that was known as "Bob Crosby's Bob Cats" is no longer in existence.

Bob is the head man on this show, breaking forth with patter and song, but the music belongs to Jerry Gray. And there's a mighty good reason why Jerry Gray's "Club 15" orchestra sounds as great as it does. Every time Jerry gives the downbeat to his men, he's calling into action a total of 216 years of musical experience.

Whether it's to play an instrumental number, or the accompaniment for Bob Crosby, Jo Stafford or Gisele MacKenzie, those 216 years are what makes the band a standout musical organization.

With but one exception, all of the men have spent 10 years or more as professional musicians. Trombonist Murray McEachern has the longest period of service—28 years. Two of the men, Stanley Wrightman and Gil Ren, each have 20 years apiece.

Leader Gray can chalk up some 18 years of composing, arranging, conducting and playing. It was Jerry who was responsible for many of the famed Glenn Miller orchestral arrangements, and, upon the death of Miller, Jerry took over the leadership of the outfit.

A check of the past history of most of the boys reveals activities as Benny Goodman, Raymond Scott, Tommy Dorsey, Artie Shaw, Paul Whiteman, Vincent Lopez and Woody Herman. Strangely enough, after 216 combined years of making music their business, the "Club 15ers" still call their work play.
