Army Seeks 10,000,000 Pounds of Foreign Meat

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The army announced Friday it wants to buy 10,000,000 pounds of foreign meat for use in the United States. The announcement said up to 25 per cent of this could be merely "good" meat instead of the customary "choice" quality.

The army is seeking another 10,000,000 pounds in overseas markets to supply its troops in Europe.

It got only two bids on that first offer and rejected both. The bids were for a total of 3,920,000 pounds of the lowest "commercial" grade.

To bring beef into the country, the army must invoke a provision of the "buy American" act, which allows such military purchases when an emergency exists.

The bids previously rejected were from Brazil and Uruguay, which offered 560,000 pounds and 3,360,000 pounds of beef respectively.

The army said those offers failed to meet U. S. standards.

Polio in U. S. Declines for 3rd Week in Row

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Polio has declined for the third week in a row, the public health service said Friday.

This would indicate that the disease reached its peak this year in the week ending Sept. 8 when 1,871 new cases were reported. The peak last year was reached in the week ending Sept. 23, and the year before in the week ending Aug. 20.

New cases reported during the past week ending Sept. 22 totaled 1,746, compared with 1,797 in the week ending Sept. 15.
