

LOOKING AND LISTENING**Television Science Degree Offered USC Students**

HOLLYWOOD. The first degree in television to be offered by any college or university in the nation will be offered students at the University of Southern California, beginning with the spring semester starting Feb. 7, 1952. The degree of Bachelor of Science in Television came about as a result of the announcement by Capt. Allan Hancock, chairman of the University of Southern California's board of trustees, that he would offer it as a gift, money in excess of \$100,000 for the building and equipping of television studios, sets, control rooms and laboratories in the Hancock Building on the university campus.

All real equipment will be put into use for the course, which will allow actual student operations and make it possible to means of microwave relay, to feed special programs to the existing seven Los Angeles commercial television stations.

Work has already begun in the Hancock Building on the studies and the complete order of the latest and most modern equipment should be installed by Dec. 1. Equipment includes: Two studio cameras; 1000 feet of cable (which will allow programming in science and arts laboratories in the Hancock Building), a film chain camera for work with film and slides; complete monitoring equipment and studio control gear, plus the usual generators and lights for effects and staging.

The course falls under the regular four-year college term, however, a special certificate in television is being offered for those who wish to attend a two-hour course once a week for a total of 60 hours. Just the certificate is given for this study, and not the Bachelor of Science degree.

The present Bachelor of Arts degree for radio and television will continue to be given, but in this case the course is not so from KECA at 9:30.


