Two to Die, Nine Sent to Prison by Poland  
 WARSAW, Poland, Oct. 17. (AP) Two men were condemned to death and nine others, including four Roman Catholic priests, were sentenced to prison yesterday on conviction of joining in underground activities against the Communist government.

185 More Casualties  
 WASHINGTON, Oct. 17. (AP) The Defense Department today identified 185 more battle casualties in Korea. A new list (No. 421) reported 36 killed, 131 wounded, 12 missing in action and six injured in combat accidents.

### President Signs Bill to Use Sub in Tests

WASHINGTON, Oct. 17. (AP) President Truman has signed a bill permitting the Navy to convert the unfinished submarine Ula into an experimental ship to test "shock resistance" of atomic submarine equipment.

The Ula will be blasted by depth charges to determine how they affect certain secret equipment to be carried by atomic-powered subs. The Navy said the tests have the "highest priority," but did not reveal when or where they will be held.
