# PIGGLY WIGGLY'S "GOOD MENU" PARADE

**A** MAN chose this dish. It's Cranberry Ham, and it's a favorite with Igor Gorin, baritone headliner of concert, opera and radio. Like many another musician, Gorin has made cooking a hobby. Often he experiments, and invents new dishes. This recipe for Cranberry Ham is one of them. You'll find that it's really unusual — new, unexpected flavors, created with "stand-by" ingredients. Add a vegetable, tossed salad, hot rolls, a fruit dessert and coffee.

**Cranberry Ham**  
2 slices ham, about 3/4-inch thick  
Whole cloves  
2 cups fresh cranberries

1 cup strained honey  
3 tablespoons prepared horseradish  
1/2 lemon, juice

Slash fat edges of ham slices at half-inch intervals to prevent curling. Stud fat with whole cloves. Put cranberries through food chopper, using coarse knife. Combine honey, horseradish and lemon juice. Place 1 slice ham in baking dish; cover with half the cranberries. Top with second ham slice and remaining cranberries. Pour honey mixture over all. Bake in moderate oven, 325 deg. F., 1 1/2 hours, basting often with liquid in pan. Makes 8 servings.
