**STORY:** The entire picture centers around the life of Cyrano—and his big nose—who, in addition to his being a soldier in the French army, is a poet, playwright, journalist, and the best swordsman in Paris. His nose, which is the bane of his existence, is the cause of his fear to tell the woman he loves his true feelings. When she falls in love with Christian, another soldier in his regiment, Cyrano agrees to supply the sweet nothings which Christian tells and writes the beautiful Roxane. Christian and Roxane are married, but he is immediately called off to war, along with Cyrano and another of Roxane's suitors. Christian is killed and it is not until many years later that Roxane finds out the truth about who wrote Christian's love letters.
