Song Hit Put Washburne Back in Music Business

HOLLYWOOD, Country Washburne, bandleader on the KNX-CBS radio series, "Curt Massey Time," is a topflight music arranger and writer of hit songs—but a lot of his friends still remember when he quit music completely to take a job pumping gas in a filling station.

Country reminded me of the story the other day at Columbia Square after he'd finished one of his five-times-a-week shows. We were recalling the days in 1941 when he was playing the tuba and bass fiddle with Ted Weems' band—a job which kept him on the road continually, making a normal home life for his young son practically impossible—and when we arranged for yours truly to play a fiddle number with the band (having never ever played a fiddle before). One note was all that was played, rather squeaky at times, but with the orchestra doing a series of chords which made the ultimate outcome sound like a production by Toscanini.

Around about this time, Country decided to make the break and applied for work in a filling station. The station manager couldn't imagine a musician handling a gas pump and grease rack, and, as a matter of fact, Washburne admitted, neither could he, but he got the job.

Figuring on setting down, he put his best into the job—and soon moved from the small station to a larger one; then to an even better location until by 1943 he was managing his own station.

In the meantime, a song written by Country some four years before suddenly became a nationwide success. Its title was "One Dozen Roses" and its success lifted Washburne right out of the filling station back into the music business, where he has been ever since. And doing right well.

One might feel that the song's sudden success was really the turning point in Country's life, but, as he explained, "The real turning point came when I went to work in that gas station. I was a real worrier about my future, but now I know that no matter what happens, I'll get by."

Yule Cash in Mail Needs Proper Post

A clerk was examining mail in the dead letter department of the Long Beach post office during the Christmas rush last year. . . . His job was a routine, dull one. The bored clerk plucked another letter from the pile. This one differed from the others in that it had only two cents postage and therefore was unsealed.

When the employe opened the envelope and extracted a Christmas card, a \$50 bill fluttered to the floor!

The story had a happy ending, though. A few days later an elderly gentleman identified the missive and its contents, and left the post office with the currency. Strange as it may seem, this case is not an isolated one. A startlingly high number of persons sent money unprotected through the mail each year, particularly during the Yule season.

Missives shunted to the dead-letter office are opened in order that identification might be made or that contents might be salvaged.
