"Your FBI" Scripts Go to London to Use Again

HOLLYWOOD—Last summer, Jerry Devine, producer-director of ABC's "This Is Your FBI" radio program, spent six weeks in Europe on vacation. While in London, he met Percy Hoskins, top crime reporter for the London Daily Express. Hoskins, at the time, was producing a documentary series called "I Made News" on the British Broadcasting Co. television network. It was his conviction that a documentary on the exploits of the Federal Bureau of Investigation would be a big success in England despite local competition from the famed Scotland Yard. Devine agreed and, on his return home, sent Hoskins an old "This Is Your FBI" radio script which was adapted to television for the experiment.

Mate's Yule Gift Fatal to Wife

WEST MEMPHIS, Ark., Dec. 3. (AP) A young mother was killed near here yesterday by an accidental blast from a shotgun she had just given her husband as an early Christmas gift.

Mrs. Arnold McFarland, 26, was hit by a charge from the new automatic while she, her husband, and two companions were hunting rabbits.

McFarland told officers he hit his wife when he shot at a rabbit, lowered the gun, and it suddenly fired again. Mrs. McFarland was standing 15 feet away.

The McFarlands, both of West Memphis, were accompanied on the hunt by her brother, Ralph McFarland of West Memphis, and Donald Devazier of nearby Marion.

Deputy Sheriff C. M. Rieves said McFarland told him the shotgun apparently fired when McFarland stumbled after shooting at the rabbit.
