Announcers on Sports TV Shows May Talk Too Much

By KING CHARLES Certain viewers who look upon themselves as experts at watching football on TV are saying they think some of the announcers who supply word pictures for the gridiron scenes are overdoing it. They say there has been a tendency to forget that the audience is watching too, particularly by sportscasters who have been radio trained, where their voices must be the "eyes" of the listeners.

Recent examples came in the double-header week end when Jim Britt told about the Army Navy game and right afterward Mel Allen described Notre Dame Southern California. In one instance, sometimes things on the screen were just the reverse of the description, while in the other over-talking tended to develop. The same comments are heard about too much comment on wrestling and other events. The Wednesday night prize fights from New York usually are silent during furious punching.

Jerry Lester finally got back into his television stride in his third appearance as part of the Bob Hope-Fred Allen-Dragnet Sunday night cycle from New York. Instead of trying to be someone he wasn't, he brought along some of the antics in which he specialized when he was a part of the Dumont Cavalcade of Stars and the later Broadway Open House of NBC-TV. The show was more of a laugh throughout instead of in spots, particularly the third revival of his phone quiz skit.

The week end also provided the TV debut of Ethel Barrymore. "First lady of the theater," another of the special guests of Jimmy Durante, who has invited such personalities as Helen Traubel and Margaret Truman to join in comedy-teaming. Miss Barrymore's appearance, while it led to the anticipated hilarity with dignity, possibly did not supply as much as did her predecessors. Jimmy's next guest will be a return visit of Miss Traubel, her third, on Dec. 29.

Taxable Sales Near Record

SACRAMENTO, Dec. 5. (AP) Taxable sales in California in July, August and September topped three and a third billion dollars and were within less than 3 per cent of the all time high, reports the State Board of Equalization. It was the fifth straight three-month period in which sales subject to the 3 per cent sales tax were higher than \$3,000,000,000. The record was established in the final quarter of 1950. Based on a sampling of larger taxpayers' returns, the July-August-September sales totaled \$3,334,000,000. The big gain was in manufacturing, wholesaling and contracting establishments. Durables goods dealers did a less business, than in the same period of 1950, and dealers in non-durable goods did a little more.
