High Court Asked to Settle Judge's Feud with Marcus
(By United Press)
The state supreme court was asked Friday to settle a feud between Motor Commissioner Ben Marcus and Chippewa County Judge Orin Larrabee over who has the last word in issuing occupational driver's licenses.
Meanwhile, the court stopped Larrabee's move to order Marcus to appear before him and explain why an occupational driver's license shouldn't be issued to William H. Hebert, Chippewa Falls.
Roy Tulane of the attorney general's office asked the high court to restrain Larrabee permanently from further proceedings in Hebert's request for a license.
Tulane said that if Marcus had to appear in county courts to explain his reason for rejecting applications for licenses, the motor vehicle commissioner would have 1,000 cases like it a year.
"If this were allowed to continue," Tulane said, "it would tie the hands of a public officer."
Marcus won the first round recently when the high court ruled that Larrabee couldn't cite him for contempt in refusing to grant an occupational driver's license ordered by the judge in another case.
Larrabee then ordered Marcus to appear at Chippewa Falls to explain why Hebert shouldn't get a license. Marcus countered with a request that the high court stop the judge's order.
The supreme court issued a temporary stop order until it can reach a decision.

2 City Men Get Jail for Giving Whisky to Boy, 15
Otto Charles Pommering, 51, and Dennis William Mullins, 57, two Madison pinsetters, were each sentenced to 30 days in jail Friday by Superior Judge Roy H. Proctor for giving whisky to a 15-year-old Madison boy who was setting pins with them Nov. 23 at the Row-A-Vard alleys, 2909 E. Washington ave.
The boy testified that he asked for a drink and the two men gave him their bottle. He passed out on the sidewalk in the 2700 block of Union st. later and was taken by police to a hospital for treatment.
Pommering and Mullins, both of whom have long records of drunkenness and vagrancy arrests, conducted their case in court without the aid of an attorney. They claimed the boy drank from their bottle without their knowledge.
They both have been in jail since Nov. 23 awaiting trial and Judge Proctor ordered their 30-day sentences to begin as of that day.
Proctor also ordered the boy turned over to county juvenile authorities for supervision.
