Joel McCrea Discusses Young, New Radio Actors

HOLLYWOOD. Dropped in the Joel McCrea, "Tales of the Texas Rangers" studio the other day during a rehearsal, and left rather pleased after a lengthy discussion with Joel on radio and radio actors. He never finishes a rehearsal or a broadcast without his respect for the hard-working, near-anonymous AFRA (American Federation of Radio Actors) zooming up to a new peak.

"They're amazing," said McCrea in his slow drawl. "They'll walk into the studio pick up a script and, without hesitation, launch into any one of a thousand characterizations. 'I've seen young girls play old women, old women play children of school age, dignified-looking men play vicious cutthroats.' But it isn't the fact that these versatile actors can change their voices which surprises McCrea. It's the understanding they bring to a role with, in relation to films of the stage, the briefest of rehearsals. 'People like Herb Butterfield, Paul Frees, Lurene Tuttle, Virginia Gregg and dozens more,' McCrea said, 'must have some great, instinctive knowledge of life. They can re-create the feeling of a mother losing her child or a man bent on revenge or a murderer filled with fear, with the greatest accuracy. How they do it—I don't know.'"

McCrea, of course, had done very little radio work prior to starting this series based on the files of the famed Texas Rangers, and he hasn't had much chance to work with radio actors. He admits that in the past he just took them all for granted, and never really realized just how much they contributed to the acting profession. They rarely become big stars, says McCrea, but with-out them, the so-called big stars would be helpless. Joel has one surprise that he never forgets. It's a little old woman. The previous week she played a grand-mother and he figured this time she'd do a similar role. Much to his surprise, she played the vixen in the show, a girl with a throaty voice and loads of sex appeal.
